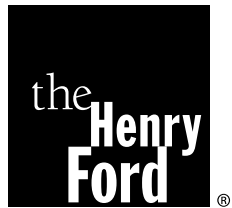

Greenfield Village | 10AM-1PM

May 22

Rosa Parks took a stand by sitting down; now it is your turn to take a stand. Express your views through different hands-on activities, and join women from the past in your first historic vote at *Henry Ford Museum*.
